Executive Summary 2016

Mission: The mission of Columbia Elementary of Columbia Elementary is for faculty, students and families to work together to achieve academic success and social confidence in a safe learning environment.

After a thorough review of multiple lines of data, the School Improvement Team determined that the greatest academic need is to ensure students are receiving the highest quality instruction and making positive academic growth of at least one year during each instructional year. We must provide a three-tiered intervention plan for all students to achieve to their highest academic potential in language arts and math. It is also critical that we provide a learning environment that is safe and welcoming to students, parents, staff, and community members. As a result, we set the following goals in the areas of Language Arts, Math, and Culture and Climate.

DECREASE THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS NOT MAKING PROFICIENCY LEVEL IN LANGUAGE ARTS AND MATHEMATICS BY 7% AS ASSESSED BY THE SAGE EXAMS AT THE END OF EACH SCHOOL YEAR.

- TEACHERS WILL COLLABORATE WEEKLY IN PROFESSIONAL LEARNING COMMUNITIES (PLC'S) TO REVIEW AND ANALYZE STUDENT DATA AND REVIEW BEST TEACHING PRACTICES TO MEET ALL STUDENTS CULTURAL AND DIVERSE NEEDS.
- ALL STUDENTS, GRADES 1-6, WILL CONSISTENTLY RECEIVE EFFECTIVE LITERACY AND MATH INSTRUCTION DAILY. AT LEAST 30 MINUTES, DAILY, OF TIER II LITERACY AND MATH INTERVENTIONS WILL BE PROVIDED FOR EVERY STUDENT SCORING BELOW PROFICIENCY LEVELS ON JORDAN DISTRICT BENCHMARKS.
- INCREASE COMMUNICATION REGARDING LITERACY AND MATH INSTRUCTION BETWEEN HOME AND SCHOOL FROM PRESENT LEVELS.
- DECREASE BY 10% BOTH MINOR AND MAJOR INAPPROPRIATE STUDENT BEHAVIORS REQUIRING INTERVENTION, EACH YEAR.
- CREATE A SYSTEM OF SUPPORT TO HELP ALL STUDENTS AND THEIR FAMILIES MEET THEIR COMPLEX NEEDS THROUGH SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY SERVICES.
