## **III: Review the Land Trust Plan for 2020-2021**

1. \$84,303 in Land Trust funds for 2020-2021
  - a. 1 ESL endorsed teacher and 2 instructional aides: \$82,003
  - b. Professional Development: \$300
  - c. Instructional support materials: \$2,000
2. Goal: 5% increase in student proficiency on Math and Language Arts SAGE/RISE and Acadience testing.
3. **Action Steps**
  - a. Teachers will collaborate together in Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) in order to analyze student data, discuss and implement high impact teaching strategies and coordinate interventions for students
4. **Latino Appreciation Night**
  - a. Depending on COVID situation would like to do it in the spring
  - b. Needs to be authentic and not stereotypical
  - c. Reach out to community members
  - d. Coordinate with the Family Learning Center, Latinos in Action at West Jordan High
5. **School Safety**
